Nomination Process

- Any member of the Wilton Warriors FC community (player, parent, coach, manager, or volunteer) is welcome to submit a nomination.
- All nominations must be submitted electronically - [through this form](#).
- All questions must be answered for the nomination to be considered for judging.
- Nominations close **midnight Friday, September 5, 2025**.

Selection Process

- The Wilton Warriors FC Committee will review all submissions after the close date.
- Winners will be selected based on the answers to the criteria for the relevant category, and the examples provided.
- The decision of the committee is final.

Award Presentation

Recipients of each Award will be formally announced and celebrated at the Wilton Warriors FC end-of-season celebrations. A full list of recipients will be posted on the Wilton Warriors FC social media accounts following the Senior end-of-season celebration on Saturday, October 25.

Nomination Form Questions

Below are the general questions that need to be answered as part of the nomination process. The specific questions per category as included in the [award descriptors](#).

1. Your Full Name
2. What is your relationship with the nominee/team/family?
(eg. teammate, parent, coach etc)
3. What category are you submitting the nomination for?

The specific questions for each category will pop up once you choose the category

4. Does the nominee/team/family know you are submitting this nomination?
5. Is there anything else you would like to add to support your nomination?

Award Descriptors

Junior/Senior Warrior Spirit Award

Description

Awarded to the individual who best embodies the core values of the Wilton Warriors—resilience, courage, sportsmanship, passion, and a never-give-up attitude.

Eligibility

Open to all players, coaches, and volunteers.

Wilton Warriors Committee members are not eligible.

Nomination Criteria

- Demonstrates outstanding commitment to their team and club.
- Displays positivity and grit regardless of game results.
- Lifts others up with encouragement and action.

Judging Criteria

- Alignment with club values.
- Visible impact on team morale or performance.
- Consistency of behaviour throughout the season.

Nomination Questions

1. How has this person demonstrated the "Warrior Spirit" this season?
2. Share an example of a moment(s) where they inspired others.

Black & Gold Heart Award

Description

Given to someone whose dedication to the club shines in everything they do—on and/or off the field—promoting positivity, pride, loyalty, inclusion, community and love for the black and gold.

Eligibility

Players, coaches, volunteers, or supporters.

Wilton Warriors Committee members are not eligible.

Nomination Criteria

- Lives and breathes the club culture.
- Proudly represents the club in the community.

Judging Criteria

- Contribution to club culture.
- Club advocacy or promotion.
- Visible pride in Wilton Warriors identity.

Nomination Questions

1. How does this nominee represent the heart of the Wilton Warriors?
2. What contributions have they made to the culture at the club?
3. Please share a specific moment or story that shows why this person deserves this award.

Quiet Achiever Award

Description

For the humble Warrior who doesn't seek the spotlight but delivers results, shows leadership by example, and makes an impact without seeking attention or recognition.

Eligibility

All club members, excluding Wilton Warriors Committee members.

Nomination Criteria

- Consistently dependable and committed.
- Delivers excellence without fanfare.
- Often overlooked but deeply valued.

Judging Criteria

- Contributions that fly under the radar.
- Impact on the team and/or the club.
- Dedication over personal recognition.

Nomination Questions

1. How has this person gone above and beyond for their team or the club?
2. Why do you believe they deserve recognition?

Junior/Senior - Team of the Year

Description

Celebrating the team that represents the best of Wilton Warriors—on-field performance/improvement, sportsmanship, spirit, and club involvement.

Eligibility

All Wilton Warriors teams (junior and senior).

Nomination Criteria

- Positive team culture.
- Competitive or developmental growth.
- Contributions to club spirit and events.

Judging Criteria

- Results and improvement.
- Sportsmanship and unity.
- Involvement in club activities and initiatives.

Nomination Questions

1. Why is this team a standout this year?
2. What makes their journey special or inspiring?

Volunteer of the Year

Description

Recognising a volunteer who has gone above and beyond to support the club, its players, and the community.

Eligibility

All club members, excluding Wilton Warrior Committee members.

Nomination Criteria

- Regular contribution of time and effort.
- Positive influence across the club.
- Willingness to help wherever needed.

Judging Criteria

- Scope of volunteer impact.
- Enthusiasm and reliability.
- Nominee's embodiment of club spirit.

Nomination Questions

1. Describe the contributions this volunteer has made.
2. Why does this individual stand out as our 'behind-the-scenes' hero this year?

Warrior Family Award

Description

Awarded to a family whose collective contributions—on and off the field—make the club stronger, warmer, and more connected.

Eligibility

Families with at least one registered player in the club.

Wilton Warriors Committee members are ineligible.

Nomination Criteria

- Involvement across multiple club roles or events.
- Supportive and inclusive club behaviour.
- Represent the club positively as a family unit.

Judging Criteria

- Broad family engagement.
- Positive club impact.
- Club representation as a united front.

Nomination Questions

1. How has this family contributed to the club?
2. What makes them the epitome of a “Warrior Family”?

Junior/Senior - The 'Lead the Charge' Award

Description

Given to someone who consistently leads by example, motivates others, and steps up when it counts most.

Eligibility

Open to players, coaches and managers.

Wilton Warriors Committee members are ineligible.

Nomination Criteria

- Demonstrates leadership both vocally and by action.
- Champions their team and club culture.
- Steps up in critical moments.

Judging Criteria

- Visible leadership on and off the field.
- Inspires peers to improve.
- Shows initiative to solve problems.

Nomination Questions

1. In what ways has this person led the charge for their team?
2. Share a moment where their leadership was critical.

The Rising Warrior

Description

Recognising a junior player who has shown immense growth, potential, and a love for the game throughout the season.

Eligibility

Wilton Warriors players aged between 5–14.

Nomination Criteria

- Significant improvement or personal growth.
- Passionate about learning and playing.
- Demonstrates Warrior values for their age group.
- Positively influences those around them.

Judging Criteria

- Measurable development and effort.
- Attitude and teamwork.
- Love for football and club pride.

Nomination Questions

1. How has this young Warrior grown over the season?
2. What sets them apart among their peers?

Warrior of the Week Photo of the Year

Description

Celebrating the most iconic, funny, or heartfelt Warrior of the Week moment captured on camera in 2025.

Eligibility

Any Warrior of the Week photo from the season.

Wilton Warrior Committee members are ineligible.

Nomination Criteria

- Captures the essence of the club (fun, effort, joy, pride).
- Evokes emotion—laughter, pride, inspiration.
- Well-timed or creatively composed.

Judging Criteria

- Emotional impact.
- Representation of club values.
- Story behind the image.

Nomination Questions

1. Why does this photo stand out as the best of 2025?
2. What's the story behind the moment captured?
